MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

For Academic and Research Collaboration Between

Management Development Institute of Singapore, Tashkent, Uzbekistan,

And Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov, Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan

Management Development Institute of Singapore in Tashkent (MDIS Tashkent), in the person of the rector J. Salikhov, on the one hand, and Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov, Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, represented by the rector M. Chynybaev, on the other hand, have agreed to the following areas of collaboration on academic and research related activities.

1. Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- 1) Developing research projects jointly and avail funding
- 2) Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities
- 3) Conduct of Joint symposium, seminar/conferences, and workshops.
- 1.1 Both institutions seek to facilitate research collaboration between their faculties through sharing of research ideas, data, and academic resources that could lead to joint Publications. Such opportunities may include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's institution. Faculty from both Institutions will collaborate in the supervision of exchange students and in joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in Annexure 1 or terms and conditions laid out by separate written agreement by both Institutions. All financial issues will be resolved by an additional agreement
- 1.2 Faculty from both institutions may exchange academic information (scholarly information, materials and publications etc.). Both the institutions may advertise the collaboration under this Memorandum among their students, staff etc. Where reasonably possible, in making advertisements or public announcements in relation to this Memorandum, each institution shall acknowledge the participation of the other institution and the contribution that other party has made.
- 1.3 Both Universities will try to enhance the collaboration by organizing conferences, Cooperative Seminars, and engaging on conclaves, symposiums and other academic meetings if specific grants are available.

2. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This Memorandum will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the both institutions and will remain in effect for five (5) years. This Memorandum may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both Institutions. If either institution wishes to terminate the Memorandum at the end of the five years period or in between the period of five years, it must notify the other institution not less than six months prior to the expiry of the Memorandum. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party. This agreement or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties.

3. Resolution of Disputes:

In the event of any unforeseen issues or matters not covered herein or any controversy, dispute or difference arising out or in connection with or in relation to this Memorandum, the same shall be resolved amicably by both the institutions.

This MOU may be signed in counterpart. Each counterpart will constitute an original document and these counterparts taken together, shall constitute one and the same Memorandum.

1. Proposals for collaborative research work under this Memorandum will be submitted with the prior approval of the Head of each institution, or his / her nominee.

2. Each institution will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.

3. Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated authorities of both parties.

4. The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of guaranteed support funds.

5. Neither Management Development Institute of Singapore in Tashkent (MDIS Tashkent) nor Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov will be held responsible for any liability to the other party, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against loss or damage to any property due to activities to which this agreement relates. Every collaboration will have its own agreement / contract which address issues such as IPR, funding pattern, disclosure of information etc.
